

SECOND AMENDED CHARTER AGREEMENT  
OF THE  
SOUTHEASTERN VIRGINIA JOB TRAINING ADMINISTRATION  
formerly known as  
SOUTHEASTERN TIDEWATER AREA MANPOWER AUTHORITY

Whereas, effective July 1, 1974, the Cities of Chesapeake, Franklin, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk and Virginia Beach, and the Counties of Isle of Wight and Southampton did join together to create the Southeastern Tidewater Area Manpower Authority (STAMA) as a joint venture, and

Whereas, the participating jurisdictions did effective October 1, 1983, amend the Charter of the Southeastern Tidewater Area Manpower Authority in certain respects, and

Whereas, the participating jurisdictions do hereby desire to amend the name and reaffirm the Charter in all other respects as follows:

THIS SECOND AMENDED CHARTER AGREEMENT made this first day of January, 1985, by and between the Cities of Chesapeake, Franklin, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, and Counties of Isle of Wight, and Southampton, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 15.1-21 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. That participating jurisdictions did join effective July 1, 1974, to create the Southeastern Tidewater Area Manpower Authority (STAMA) a joint venture between the Cities of Chesapeake, Franklin, Norfolk, Portsmouth, Suffolk, and Virginia Beach and the Counties of Isle of Wight and Southampton, and do desire to amend that Charter in the limited respect contained below.
2. The consortium chartered the 1st day of July, 1974, by the Cities and Counties signatory thereto as the Southeastern Tidewater Area Manpower Authority shall, effective January 1, 1986, be named the Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration (SVJTA).
3. The Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration, formerly the Southeastern Tidewater Area Manpower Authority shall exist in perpetuity, subject however to dissolution by agreement of the governing bodies of the participating jurisdictions.
4. The Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration shall have for its purpose the provision of employment and training services in accordance with the provisions of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982, or any subsequent legislation of similar import.
5. The Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration shall be governed by a Policy Council consisting of an elected or appointed official, designated by the governing body of

each participating jurisdiction and an elected official appointee from the Southeastern Virginia Planning District Commission.

6. The Policy Council shall meet at least quarterly.

7. The Policy Council is hereby authorized and empowered:

(a) To adopt By-Laws for the regulation of its affairs and the conduct of SVJTA business;

(b) To adopt an official seal and alter the same at its pleasure;

(c) To maintain an office at such place or places as it may designate;

(d) To sue and be sued;

(e) To accept grants and gifts from the participating jurisdictions, the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Federal government or any other governmental bodies or political subdivision, and from any unit, private corporation, copartnership, association or individual;

(f) To enter into contracts with the Federal government, the Commonwealth of Virginia, any political subdivision, or any agency or instrumentality thereof, or with any unit, private corporation, private industry council, copartnership, association, or individual providing for or relating to the furnishing of employment and training services;

(g) To employ such professional staff and clerical employees as may be deemed necessary, and to prescribe their powers and duties and fix their compensation;

(h) To make and enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the performance of its duties and the execution of its powers hereunder, except contracts or agreements for the borrowing of money for which the express written consent of each participating jurisdiction must be obtained;

(i) To do all acts and things necessary or convenient to carry out its purposes and powers.

8. The Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration shall be financed by State and/or Federal grants and by such contributions by the participating jurisdictions as shall be mutually agreed upon.

9. Any participating jurisdiction may withdraw from this agreement as of the last day of June in any year, provided it gives written notice thereof to the Policy Council prior to the first day of March preceding the date of withdrawal.


10. Upon the dissolution of the Southeastern Virginia Job Training Administration, all of its assets and property shall be disposed of as determined by the Policy Council.

11. All real and personal property shall be acquired, and held in the name of Southeastern Virginia Job Training

Administration and disposed of by the Policy Council in accordance with Rules and Regulations adopted and promulgated thereby.






COUNTY OF ISLE OF WIGHT






CITY OF NORFOLK




